ULEPAC Fundraising

Our fundraisers continue to be successful and the money raised benefits our children in many ways. Thank you for your ongoing support! The annual PAC budget is drafted with input from teachers, administration and parent feedback. Everything on the budget must fall within district policy and guidelines and as such there are constraints on how fundraised money can be spent. For example, the PAC cannot purchase curricular items for students such as textbooks. The proposed budget is presented at the AGM and can only be approved by majority vote.

All profits from Orange Shirt Day (\$1,319) and Pink Shirt Day (\$520) were donated to the Orange Shirt Society and CKNW Kid's Fund respectively.
